
Once the selection of participants is completed, you will receive:

- The programme of the activities and some tasks will help you to become more prepared for the Youth Exchange;
- Some practical information (how to get there, weather, currency etc);
- A form where you can share with us your dietary requirements, other preferences and emergency contacts;
- An invitation for a preparatory on-line meeting
- An invitation for the Facebook group of the project, where we will start getting in touch with everyone.

Intercultural evening

Selected participants will be request to prepare the activities for the intercultural evening:

You can bring typical food and drinks from your countries. We will have traditional evenings during the project. You can bring typical costumes, ornaments, leaflets, posters, flyers, food, sweets... Unfortunately, we don't have budget to reimburse you the expenses made for the things that you are bringing, but try to be creative and funny!



Dissemination

Every participant involved is expected to collaborate with the teammates and the sending organization to produce an article about the project' s activities and their impressions. This article should be presented on the website or social media of the partner organisation respective to their country.

Within two months of the training course each participant, individually or in teams, should arrange follow-up workshops/meeting focused on the training topic. Partner organizations will support them in the process.

Please note that the reimbursement process will not begin until the dissemination phase has been completed.



Location

You will be staying in a lovely Hostel located in Manerba d/G. The Hostel is mostly used for touristic purpose, great surroundings and next to Garda Lake beaches.

IMPORTANT: Each participants need to bring: towels and personal hygiene products. Here you can have a look of the Ostello Antica Pieve https://www.ostelloanticapieve.it/

Food: participant will be provided with 3 meals and 2 coffee breaks. Meals will be prepared by a chef. In case of external visit participants will be provided of packed lunch. Pls provide information to your sending organization about food restrictions, if any.





The closest Airport is: ORIO AL SERIO in Bergamo (Milano BGY) - www. orioaeroporto.it Other suitable airports are Verona airport, Milano Linate or Milano Malpensa.

From these Airports to Manerba d/G you have to:

-Take the shuttle (or underground in you land in Milan) from the airport (from each airport there area shuttles each 20 minuts) to the main train station (http://www.trenitalia.com/)

-Take the train with destination DESENZANO DEL GARDA.

From Desenzano train station to Manerba del Garda we will organise a private transportation to pick up participants groups.

Travel reimbursment



Travel costs will be covered, based on the country of participants, up to foreseen limits. The exact amount written on the ticket will be accepted. Travels should be by economy class and public transport.

We will refund travel tickets based on actual costs incurred and on presentation of: Invoice of the plane ticket; Boarding Pass with the clear mention of the passenger's name; All other transportation-related bills. NB. Only the travel costs for the round trip from the sending organization's country will be reimbursed.

During the activity, we will collect all the receipts and tickets, sign a reimbursement contract and, once the dissemination is completed, send you the transfer back. Please keep in mind that reimbursement will be done with one transfer to sending organisation after the project (not an individual transfers).

We will approve your request as quickly as possible so that you can make the necessary reservations

What to bring

- Necessary documents such as passports, travel documents;

- Towels (Hostel is not providing towels), personal care products, such as shower gel, shampoo, comb, etc.
- A typical taste (typical drink, food, sweets, snacks) of your Country for the "intercultural evening";
- Cameras, laptops and other equipment making life and work easier;
- Some cool pieces of music and games from your country;
- Information about your country (books, brochures, posters, postcards, video, PowerPoint presentation, music, etc.)



Personal and medical insurance are the responsibility of the individual participant. We will not be responsible for any loss of luggage, currency or personal effects, or any medical costs.

We suggest that each participants bring the European Sanitary Card in order to be safe in case of emergency.



Concerning the non EU countries, it is required that you to buy an insurance for travel.
