STUTTER LIVE



THE ISSUE

A speech disorder is a difficulty that somebody has to overcome but it should be for no reason something that will prevent somebody from fulfilling his dreams. Unfortunately, formal education can not pass this message to people regardless if they stutter or not. As a result, people who stutter remain excluded and consider Stuttering as something that tortures them from the beginning of their life. Hence, there is a certain challenge for third sector organizations to come up with effective projects and assist the formal education efforts to address the inclusion of people who Stutter.

Rowan Atkinson, King George, Demosthenes, etc are just a few examples that prove that a speech disorder cannot exclude somebody from being active in society if he/she overcomes the logophobia. According to those ideas and observations, Stutter Live was initiated in order to help society to include people who stutter and to raise awareness of what stuttering is.



THE STUTTER LIVE PROJECT

THE YOUTH EXCHANGE



CONTENT

The Stutter live youth exchange is the second part of the Stutter live project. During the 9 project days we will:

- Strengthen the active participation of young people belonging to socially vulnerable groups due to stuttering.
- Strengthen the awareness of what is stuttering and thereby create a more appropriate ground for their integration and development
- Create a safe environment in which everyone will express freely and emphasize only on the content of what they say, not the way.
- Improve participant's public speaking skills and deal with logophobia.
- Promote the benefits of Erasmus+ in the local community
- Give space to youth workers to practice their own workshops under our supervision



PARTICIPANTS

For this youth exchange, every national delegation will consist of:

- 1 group Leader over 18 y.o.
- 4 or 5 youngsters from 18 30 y.o. according to the table TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT on the last page

The **group leade**r is expected to be a person experienced in youth work and the Erasmus + Programme who is ready to facilitate the project activities and provide support to the participants during the whole project, especially during the implementation phase but also during the preparation and follow up period.

Ideally, it should be the one that took part in the Stutter live training course.







THE YOUTH EXCHANGE



VENUE

Participants will be accommodated in 4-6-8 bedrooms in a modern hostel in the heart Thessaloniki.

Stay Youth Hostel is situated really close to the main square and meeting point of Thessaloniki: Aristoteles Square

FOOD

COST

STEPS TO BUY TICKETS



- 1 Choose the most direct and economical way to travel to the venue. You can arrive 2 days earlier or depart 2 days later
- 2 Send your travel plans to our team for approval

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT

Participants' travel expenses will be reimbursed according to the Erasmus+ guidelines.

IMPORTANT: Contact the organizers BEFORE finalizing your travel arrangements

It is absolutely important that participants keep all related documents (ticket receipts/ boarding passes).

We will NOT reimburse expenses without all necessary documentation. Moreover, participants need to attend the TC in full in order to be reimbursed.













For participants arriving by plane to the renovated airport of Thessaloniki:



There are frequent bus service from the airport. The bus number is X1 (N1 in the night) and the bus stop is located just outside the Arrivals exit.

The bus ticket costs 1.8 Euro ⁻ and you can get it from the machine inside the bus (coins only).

You will take the bus until the stop (Plateia Aristotelous).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

In order to enter to Greece, you have to:

- 1.Complete the the electronic Passenger Locator Form document at least 24 hours before traveling
- 2. Meet ONE of the following criteria:
- display a negative PCR up to 72 hours before the scheduled arrival or a negative forty-eight-(48) hour diagnostic Rapid Antigen Test for COVID-19 prior to scheduled arrival of the flight
- hold a certificate of vaccination
- have a proof of recovery from COVID 19
- hold the EU digital COVID certificate
