








OBJECTIVES AND RESULTS

Team-building, ice-breaking activities to form personal connections and friendships that will help participants in the process of working together towards a common goal of the project








Accomodation:














The participants will be accommodated in rooms with 2, 3 or 4 beds and will be mixed in international groups (gender-separated of course) in hotel "Amalia" which is situated in the center of Ludbreg.

The meals throughout the period of the project will be served also in the hotel, except the coffee breaks which will be provided within the training space.


"Amalia" is 10min from a bus station and 15min from the train station. As the hotel is situated in the center, there are places to shop, pharmacy, cafe's, atm's, bank, post office etc. - all in walking range.

ARRIVAL TO THE VENUE

LUDBREG IS 80 KM FROM ZAGREB, AND 20 KM FROM VARAŽDIN AND KOPRIVNICA.

You can come anytime afternoon during the 25th to the venue but please come before dinner on 25th of April until 19:30h!

REIMBURESMENT OF TRAVEL COSTS:

All you need it to send us by email (or bring with you) all original receipts, invoices, e-tickets, and boarding passes! We strongly encourage you to buy flights that have the possibility to do online check-in so you can be able to give us the return boarding passes as well, without sending them to us by post when you return home. Of course, if for your airline is not possible, you still need to send us the boarding passes by post after the project. It is very important to have all your travel and financial documents with you for each person, otherwise, reimbursement is not possible!

Reimbursement will be done by bank transfer in the account of your sending organization, (NOT ON PERSONAL ACCOUNTS OF PARTICIPANTS) according to the rules of Erasmus

plus programme.

CURRENCY

Croatia has still (until 2023)
its own currency - kuna, be prepared to have some money exchanged to pay for the bus, train, taxi, snacks and everything you would like to buy after your arrival to the destination. You can exchange euros in the airport or big bus

1 EUR = 7,53 Kuna

and train stations, banks.

WEATHER

In April, Varazdin area, where the town of Ludbreg is situated, usually is quite warm yet don't rush to leave your jackets home. The daytime temperature goes up to +24C and may low down to +8C and even lower. Be prepared for rainy days as well, bring warm clothes and an umbrella. Of course, we can't predict the forecast and even if it will be warm, but it's better to pack some extra layers of clothes and medicine for cold/allergies.
