

Our organisation created Ecopreneurs projects family, which aims at developing soft and hard skills of youth workers and education, giving them the competences to lead the youth through the process of creating the idea for the upcycled and sewed product, designing it, developing it and preparing the business plan for the company.

The first edition of the project took place in May 2022 where 24 youth workers met to develop their competences in youth work.

Ecopreneurs 2.0 project will gather 27 youth workers and 3 trainers, who will meet between 30th of October and 8th of November 2023 in Dobczyce to develop their competencies in empowering youth through eco-entrepreneurship.

They will learn about entrepreneurship, youth empowerment, and some methods to enhance their skills, especially entrepreneurial.

Additionally, they'll gain insights into product design and business plan creation. Participants will also learn sewing and how to handcraft using old textiles, products, materials and how to give them a new life by upcycling.






ABOUT ERASMUS+

This program aims to modernize education, training and youth work across Europe. It offers exciting opportunities for participants to study, work, volunteer, learn and train abroad in Europe.






Youth Act Poland



OBJECTIVES


- Developing the competencies of youth workers to support migrants, NEETs and youth with fewer opportunities to develop their competencies and increase their employability
- Developing youth workers' soft skills and competencies in handcrafting, sewing, entrepreneurship, and youth empowerment
- Developing competencies in the Project Based Learning approach
- Creating opportunities for participants to learn about product design and business planning models
- Creating opportunity for participants to learn how to create and develop eco-friendly products from upcycled materials through sewing and handcrafting in two categories (intercultural and inclusive fashion, practical upcycled solutions products)
- Promoting eco-entrepreneurship, upcycling, environmental protection, social inclusion, active citizenship, cultural and social diversity
- Promoting NFE, Erasmus+ and ESC programmes between youth and stakeholders





PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

- Youth workers, youth educators, leaders
- Communicative level of English
- Age limit minimum 18 years old
- Motivation to experience NFE methodology
- Motivation to experience and learn about eco-entrepreneurship and sewing
- Motivation to take an active part in all workshops during the activity
- Willing to promote the project during all phases via social media
- Willing to run the follow-up activities





During the training, participants will take part in workshops based on a non-formal educational approach and experiential learning, where they will learn how to use the sewing machines, make small handcrafts and learn about entrepreneurship (especially eco-entrepreneurship), all this in the context of zero waste, upcycling and pro-ecological approach.

The non-formal education methods will, above all, include group and individual work, team building activities and practical workshops raising skills around sewing, upcycling and entrepreneurship.






ACTIVITIES

The activities will be based on three pillars: entrepreneurship, ecology, sewing and handcrafting.

The first part of the training is dedicated to learning about entrepreneurship, eco-entrepreneurship, youth empowerment, sewing, handcrafting and learning how to make sewing projects from old materials and clothes.

The second part of the training would be dedicated to developing ideas and creating the final eco-products and business plans for eco-enterprises.

Daily there would be at least 6 hours of workshops and time for reflection (every day we will start workshops at 9:30 and finish around 19 o'clock, with two coffee breaks and a lunch break).


VENUE & LIVING CONDITIONS

The training course will take place in Dobczyce - a small village near Kraków. Participants will stay in bedrooms (2-3 people in rooms with the same gender) with bathrooms. All activities will take place in the workshop room in the next building.

In the venue, there is a canteen which will provide the meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and coffee breaks.

Together we will take care of the space where we will live, work and learn, therefore we need to keep the place clean and useful for our activities.






ACTIVE PARTICIPATION

- Accomplishment of all tasks connected with the dissemination of the project and its follow-up phase






FOLLOW UP ACTIVITIES

Participants after attending the full training course will receive the YouthPass certificates.



WHAT TO BRING

- One computer per the national team
- European insurance card or Insurance for travelling in Poland
- Positive attitude
- Clear mind without the stress of doing some work/home tasks during the TC
- Comfortable clothes and shoes for the workshops which will take place mainly indoors
- Cosmetics (soap, shampoo etc.)
- Traditional food, drinks and souvenirs for intercultural evenings
- Personal medicines (as our team cannot provide any kind of medicine to participants)
- Textiles, old clothes you're not using anymore for the sewing projects






TRAVEL

Due to environmental protection, we are recommending lowering the carbon emission during travel (taking in first choice train/bus transportation or direct flights).

Selected participants could start to find a connection to Kraków. Please, send us a proposal for your travel (which includes the travel company, time and date of arrival and departure, and price). Later you should wait for our confirmation to buy them. Tickets bought without our confirmation will be not reimbursed. More about the reimbursement process, in the next section.

Tickets should be bought at low fare prices, only second class.






ACT

The participation fee is the participants' contribution to the organisation of the project.






MEETING POINT

On the 30th of October, we are going to meet around 18 o'clock <u>near the main train station</u> in Krakow. Then we will go by shuttle bus to our venue (the cost of the shuttle bus will be reduced from the travel reimbursement limits).

Plan your travel to be on the 30th of October before 18 o'clock in Krakow around the train station. On the 8th of November we will leave our venue around 9 am in the morning, please plan your departure from Krakow after 11 o'clock (the flights from Kraków should be after 1:30 pm).

After our approval of your ticket proposal, you can buy it and upload it to our Google Drive.

The closest airports to Kraków are in Kraków, Katowice, and Warszawa. From those cities you can take the train to Kraków (check out the schedule at: http://rozkladpkp.pl/en).





REIMBURSEMENT - TASKS

Reimbursement of the tickets will be done after finalizing by participants (up to the national limits) all of the following tasks:

- Filling in the reimbursement form before the 15th of October 2023
- Sending all boarding passes and tickets to the hosting team by the 30th of November 2023
- Implementing all of the follow-up activities till 30th of December 2023
- Filling in the questionnaire after the activities till the 30th of November 2023






REIMBURSEMENT

When all participants finish all tasks we will start to reimburse your travel costs by sending transfers to each participant.

The first transfers will be sent within 2 weeks from the deadline of uploading all materials from follow-up activities (only if the participants accomplished all follow-up activities).

In case of not fulfilling all follow-up tasks activities or not sending all documents to the hosting organisation, the participant's travel reimbursement would be considered a voluntary contribution to the project.
