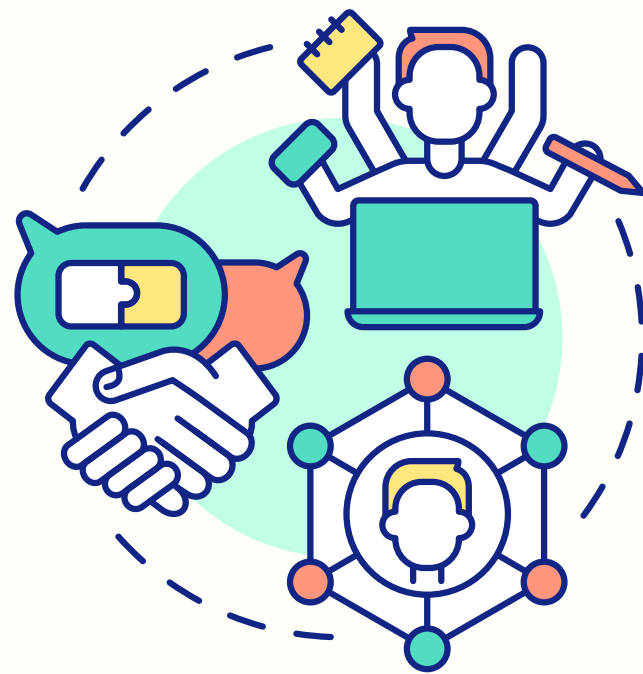

WHAT'S THE PROJECT ABOUT?



"I NEET to work" is a project aimed at young people in urban and rural areas that are not in education, employment, or training. It is organized by Hellenic Youth Participation, with the initiative of young people from Xanthi, who expressed their need for a project that will target **youth unemployment** in the area. Through the activities of this project, young people will focus and work on the topics of **employability & entrepreneurship, soft skills, European opportunities for participation, exchange of good practices, and decentralization.**

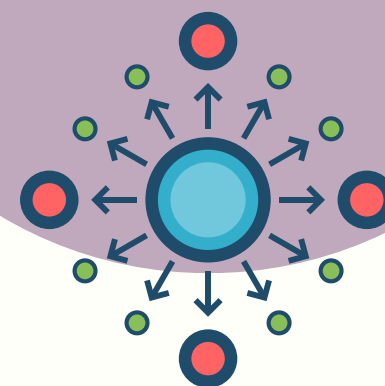

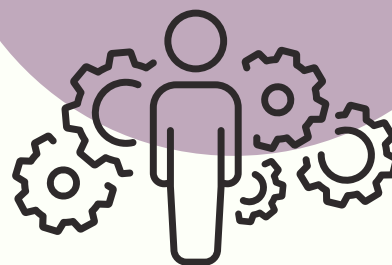

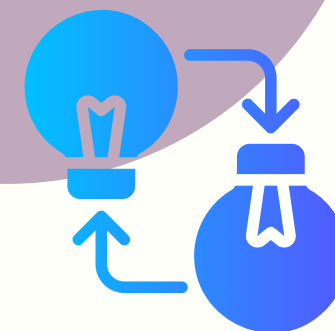

42 young people from Italy, Germany, Cyprus, Estonia, Spain, Serbia, and Greece.

- 35 of the participants (18-30 years old)
- +7 team leaders (18+ years old).
- From the 42 participants, 21 of them will be people with fewer opportunities, such as financial difficulties, geographical obstacles, social barriers, etc.

The participants should fully participate in the project and respect the schedule. With their participation, they are agreeing to be filmed and also share the objectives of the project after the end of it.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS



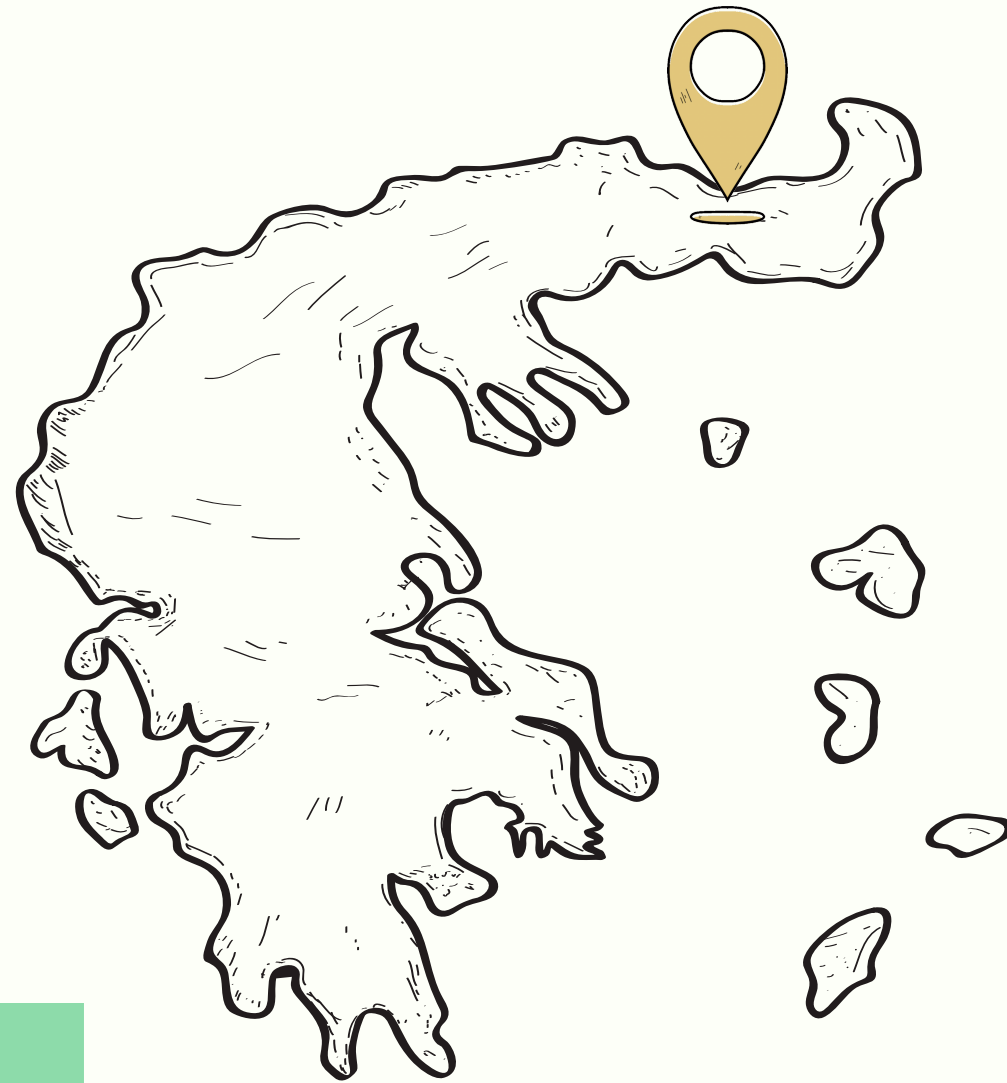
Each country will have to send **5 participants** (18-30 years old) and **1 team leader** (18+ without age limit).

The logistics for traveling are calculated according to the distance from the home country to the country of the venue.

Participants from Germany, Italy, Cyprus, Estonia → 275 euros.

Participants from Serbia → 210 euros.

Participants from Spain → 360 euros.



XANTHI

Northeastern Greece

Xanthi is a city in the region of Western Thrace and has a population of 52.278 people.

Amphitheatrically built on the foot of Rhodope mountain chain, the city is divided by the Kosynthos River, into the west part, where the old and the modern town are located, and the east part that boasts a rich natural environment.



How to arrive at Xanthi

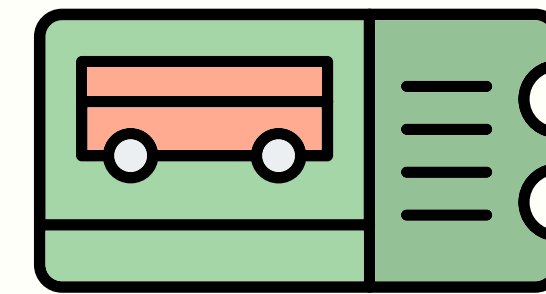
Thessaloniki airport

Fly from your country to the Thessaloniki (SKG) Airport, as it is closer to Xanthi. When you arrive, you will go to the bus station near the airport and you will get on the local bus 1X. The duration of the trip will be 40-50 minutes.

1X bus timetables

Macedonia Intercity Bus Station

You will take the local bus 1X from the airport. Then you will get off at the Macedonia Intercity Bus Station, where you will take the bus to arrive at Xanthi.



Local bus tickets

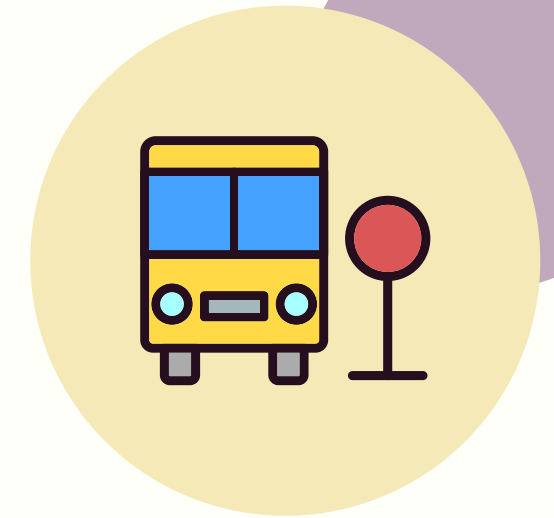
You can buy the 1X bus tickets from the vending machine inside the bus, but the vending machine **only accepts coins**. The fare for adults is 2 euros and for students and people over 65 years is 1 euro.

How to arrive at Xanthi

Macedonia Intercity Bus Station

When you will arrive at the Macedonia Intercity bus station, you will find a **bus** with the name **Ξάνθη/Xanthi** written on it. If you have difficulty finding it, visit the information desk.

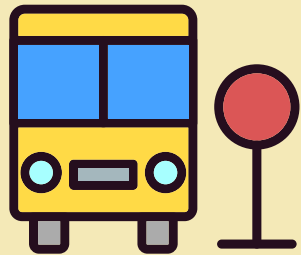
