ABOUT THE PROJECT

Sport is superpower is based on sports, outdoor education and social inclusion. Due to the extraordinary situation related to the mass migration in Europe, there is an urgent need to reduce social tensions, to raise the level of tolerance, to promote the understanding & accepting each other despite the cultural & religious differences. Our aim is with the help of sport as development tool to foster solidarity & social inclusion. One very important question might arise: how sport is related to the inclusion? We believe that sport through its universality, can transcend cultural, socioeconomic & political barriers, which is very important in an international context.

Sports are extremely powerful tools for development, especially within international communities. Moreover, sport reflects on different values & can create a bridge between different social groups forming better mutual understanding.

The answer could be reaffirmed by citing United Nations which "recognize that sport, as a tool for education, development & peace, can promote cooperation, solidarity, tolerance, understanding, social inclusion & health at the local, national & international levels."

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

- To reach personal development which helps to understand ourselves and reflect on own behavior & behavior of others;
- Challenge the perception of the structures within our society that undermine social inclusion or foster discrimination:
- Overcoming the stereotypes of different religious;
- To raise awareness on the topic of discrimination;
- To build a broader understanding of what an inclusive attitude means & to start inter cultural & inter- religious dialogue;
- To understand the connections between culture & sport & to understand the inter cultural aspects of sport
- To raise the sense of empathy towards other people.







METHODOLOGY

All the working methods will be based on the methods of nonformal education (team building activities, role-playing, simulation, group work, audiovisual methods, peer to peer learning, discussions, presentations).

6 participants + 1 Youth Leader per country

- Participants: between 18-30 years old, interested in sustainable development and climate change (please give priority to youngsters who haven't participated before in Erasmus+ projects).
- Youth Leaders: 18 + (no age limit) experienced in EU projects and preferably have skills concerning non-formal education (methods & tools)
- Keep a gender balance among participants.

Travel, finances and health insurance

- The project is funded by Erasmus+ Programme, allowing us to cover the transportation, accommodation and meals for the selected participants.
- It is mandatory to have a health insurance valid in Morocco during the period of stay, inclusive of accidents, emergencies, repatriation and civil responsibility. The health insurance cost is not subject to refund. It will be required for upload on the registration form if selected. The travel reimbursement It is also conditioned with:
- Only the travel costs that have been approved prior to booking. Hence, always consult us before booking any ticket.
- Active participation, and dissemination actions completed (sharing about the experience post-exchange)
- The participants are invited to use the cheapest means of transportation.
- It is possible to arrive and stay a maximum of 2 days before and/or after the youth exchange at the participants' own expense and responsibility given that the travel prices are not higher to those of the set dates.
- Booking flight tickets directly from the airline websites is recommended. Flight tickets should always be accompanied with the boarding passes, when requesting the travel reimbursement.
- For eco-friendliness, please proceed to buy all your tickets online and check-in online whenever possible, this will also avoid you having to send original by post delivery.








COVID-19 measures
