ABOUT THE PROJECT

Participants are going to experience a gradual and organic path that will go from personal development to intercultural society, passing through their communities.

Starting from fundamental aspects of identity-building, with particular focus on self-esteem and sense of initiative, the different experiences will be shared, so as to promote the exchange of contents based on mutual listening.

That will support the appreciation of the different socio-cultural and ethnic realities, and the beneficial provocations (as well as opportunities) that may arise from them.

Furthermore, participants will be encouraged to take challenges, not only by improving their foreign language skills, but mainly acquiring useful tools to understand better business models of local craft activities and their evolution and role in the modern globalized society.

Specifically, the learning outcomes envisaged for the participants are aimed at achieving the following skills:

- The development of a critical and proactive approach on the theme of interculturality, so as to understand through the mutual differences the common values of tolerance, freedom and respect for human rights;
- A free, aware and responsible approach to their own identity, that enables the relation with others and with the world, with the aim of fostering the development of a personal life project, and also to pursue ideals of inclusion and social solidarity;
- The detection of the value and contribution of the entrepreneurial dimension within the labor market;
- A better comprehension of the territories and their citizens, especially of the roots and the history of European peoples;
- Language skills improvement.

PARTICIPANTS

For each partner organization:

- **N° 5** youngsters (from 18 to 25 years old);
- **N° 1** youth leader (+26 years old).

This project shall include young people N.E.E.T. and/or with fewer opportunities like social-economic obstacles, cultural differences and geographical impediments.

ACCOMODATION

The project will take place in **Torre del Greco, Naples (Italy)** at the “Hotel Holidays” which is located on the beautiful city’s coast.

HOW TO GET THE VENUE

1. From **Naples International Airport**, you’ll have to take **Airbus** (ticket 5,00€) to **Napoli – Central Train Station** (Piazza Garibaldi).

2. Once there, on the lower level of the hub station, you’ll have to take **Circumvesuviana** (ticket 2,20€) from **Napoli Piazza Garibaldi** station to **Leopardi** station.

3. Then, a shuttle service shall be established from **Leopardi** station to the hotel.

FINANCIAL ASPECTS & COST REIMBURSEMENT

Reimbursements will be done in *€uro* (regardless of the currency indicated on tickets and receipts/invoices) and it will be paid to partner organizations' bank accounts not later than 3 weeks after the end of the youth exchange period.

In order to reimburse travel costs, it must be provided:

- **Boarding passes;**
 - **Invoices** of every single ticket bought (planes, trains, bus);
 - A valid **I.D. copy** (I.D. card or passport).
- Participants and youth leaders shall be required to contribute to the implementation of the activities with a sum of **5€** to be paid at the arrival.

Nota bene: boarding passes, tickets and invoices must clearly state (where applicable) the participant's name, dates and prices.

WHAT TO BRING?

- Masks and hand sanitizer;
- Comfortable clothes;
- Swimsuit and beach towels;
- Something typical from your place: food (only eat stuff out of a sealed wrapper), drinks, traditional clothes/music and any folkloric stuff. By the way, don't forget the national flag!
- At least a laptop for each country group;
- Medications/medicine you need;
- European Health Insurance Card (for EU citizens);
- Private health insurance and/or travel insurance.

Requirement for proof of negative CoViD-19 test or vaccine certification may be required.

Nota bene: The use of any kind of drug will be not tolerated at all!
