We would like to prepare ourselves and provide proper conditions for everyone, so that all participants of the project feel as good as possible in Poland.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Despite the education based on the latest knowledge, solutions and techniques, young graduates of schools and universities often have difficulties in choosing and then obtaining a satisfying attractive job. The reason for this is theoretical preparation without experience and the ability to put the acquired knowledge into practice. Young people who have not taken up a career so far have no insight into the labor market, they are not able to navigate in it. They have broad but very general and theoretical knowledge.

It would seem that young people who are fluent in modern technologies and foreign languages have particularly broad perspectives both in their country and in an increasingly open Europe in this respect. However, only theoretical preparation and lack of orientation and experience makes it difficult for us to get a job and only after employment we gain the first experiences verifying our predispositions and indicating competency shortcomings. It often turns out that our ideas about our future career and tasks that we will implement far differ from reality, and many of our preparations are of little use to us in real professional life. Many of us, after starting work, are convinced of the inaccuracy of previous educational paths and at the beginning of their careers are forced to retrain or reconcile with a job that does not give them satisfaction.

We are young people who soon will choose our further educational paths or jobs. In this project we would like to look on labor market, to get to know specific character and possibilities offered by different sectors of economy to help us to choose well and prepare to our working life. During the project we want to experience typical problems and tasks by simulation techniques connected with the reparation to working life. In this way we will verify our potential and discover the needs in relation to the various realities on the labor market. We will develop some labour competences and better understand possibilities and difficulties connected with the job in different countries. Thanks to this experiences we will elaborate our individual paths of professional and personal development that will lead us to future effective and satisfactory jobs.

10 people groups of young people (+ 1 leader) aged 20-24 from 5 countries: Poland, Greece, France, Estonia and Portugal will take part in the project. We are young people, still at schools who will soon make decision about our professional career or educational path.

During Youth Exchange we will get to know and compare the specific character of labor market in countries represented by participants and understand better the conditions of each economy sector. We will get to know some public administration and NGOs. We will challenge some tasks typical for these institutions. We will implement the simulation of municipal election and understand the mechanism and phenomenon taking place in the process of election relating to both sides (an elector, a candidate and their surroundings). We will use game simulations to experience our potential in business initiatives and analyse the mechanism of the free market. We will verify and develop our competences and predispositions relating to getting job in different economy branches. We will analyse possibilities and difficulties connected with taking a job in a foreign country. On the basis of gained experience with support of experts we will elaborate individual educational and professional path careers

The participation in the project will help us to prepare in a better way to enter the labor market. The activities implemented in the project will help us to acknowledge specific character of work in different economy sectors. The game simulations will help us to safely experience different challenges and understand the processes and mechanisms occurring in the economy sectors. Challenging the tasks connected with different economy branches we will verify our potential, resources, professional predispositions and needs in relation to taken up jobs. We will enrich our qualifications on the labor market and analyse the possibilities and challenges of getting a job in a different country.

On the grounds of the experience gained in the project we will plan our individual professional and personal career paths and thanks to it we will be able to shape our professional future. Thanks to these activities we will consciously and in a competent way make good educational choices and avoid wrong decisions. Having an insight into the realities of the labor market, we will be able to orient our further education and prepare ourselves more practically for specific professional activity.

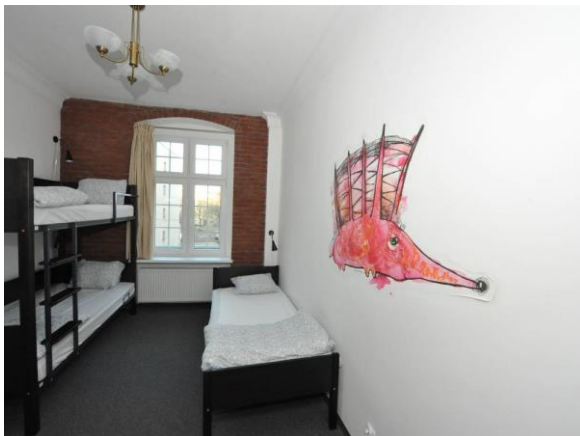

In Poland there aren't many places that EUR is accepted.

We advise to exchange EUR to PLN

There are three ways of reimbursement:

- Sending organization buys the ticket for participants –the reimbursement of the costs will be done by transfer after the mobility on the basis of an invoice made out by hosting organization with the set of tickets and boarding passes.
- Participants buy the ticket themselves – the reimbursement of the costs will be done during the mobility on the basis of the set of tickets and boarding passes
- Participants make an agreement with the hosting organisation about flights and the tickets' costs within the fixed limits- hosting organization buys the tickets and sends them via e-mail

We recommend you the third solution as neither participants nor the sending organization has to spend money before the mobility. The solution will also help us to avoid any problematic situations as ticket loss or unprofitable currency exchange. However this solution requires good and intensive cooperation to buy the tickets before the price change.
