






HOW SHOULD THE PARTICIPANTS PREPARE FOR THE YOUTH EXCHANGE?








THE VENUE STRUGA, NORTH MACEDONIA
















THE WEATHER AND USEFUL ITEMS TO BRING ALONG



August is a hot and sunny month with very few rainy days.


The participants should bring light summer clothes but also a sweatshirt/cardigan because the nights can be chilly. It is advisable to bring comfortable clothes (there is no dress code, but the participants should be wearing decent clothes). We recommend that the participants bring SPF, caps and sunglasses as part of the necessary items because if the weather allows it, some of the activities may be done outdoors and the sun is strong here.

The venue itself is located right on the shores of Lake Ohrid, so do not forget your swimsuits/swimming trunks!

Most important of all, don't forget your positive attitude!



THE WEATHER AND USEFUL ITEMS TO BRING ALONG



The participants should bring the presentations for the workshops and also it is preferable that they bring some traditional food/drinks (NO alcohol), as well as promotional materials of their organisations for the National Evenings.

As regards personal hygiene, they should bring whatever items they normally need/use.

As regards Covid-19, we expect that the situation will be safe but the host will take necessary precautions. We will discuss this the week before the exchange.

As regards health, the participants must inform the host and their sending organisations of any health conditions that may hinder or make their participation difficult. Also, each participant is responsible for bringing their prescribed mediation for any illnesses/conditions they may have.



- North Macedonia is a relatively safe country and the people are very hospitable so the participants should have a great experience.
- The police station is only a 10 minutes' walk from the venue.
- We are not an expensive country and the currency is MKD - Macedonian denar. (1 euro equals about 62 MKD)
- The nearest hospital (the city hospital is only a 15 minutes' walk) from the venue.
- There are many chemist's shops in the vicinity of the venue.
